Subject: Stop the TRV Campground

Attention: San Diego County Board of Supervisors,

I respectfully urge you to reconsider your decision to construct a campground in the Tijuana River Valley (TRV). I instead ask you to invest in green engineering techniques that will help clean the Tijuana River Valley from sewage and chemical pollution.

The TRV is regularly contaminated with unknown chemicals, plastics and human sewage. Even the Federal Customs and Border Protection agency has come forward over concern for its Border Patrol agents who are falling ill patrolling this very area where you propose a campground.

You have allocated \$5.6 million to a campground in the TRV set to begin construction in June of 2019.

This campground will pose a threat to the health and safety of those interested in the “affordable” open spaces that you are promoting. A better use of County resources would be to directly invest in fixing the sewage contamination problem. Green engineering techniques have been a proven method to improve water quality and for general environmental remediation.

I request that you utilize funds to directly address the sewage problem prior to continuing with plans for a campground in the Tijuana River Valley
